Co-ed Grass Volleyball Tournament

TOURNAMENT DATE: Saturday, Aug 1, 2026, 10 AM – 4 PM, Check-in at 9:30 AM

All games will be played on grass in Dennison Park (52 St & 7a Ave. in Tsawwassen)

GUIDELINES FOR TOURNAMENT PLAY

- All participants must be 16 years of age or older. Exceptions may be made for adequately skilled younger players at the discretion of the tournament organizers.
- Each team must have 6 players on the court at all times, with at least 2 males & 2 females.
- Teams will forfeit if they don't have all 6 players within 10 min of scheduled game start time.
- The tournament will consist of a round robin for seeding, followed by a playoff round.
- All round robin games will be timed: 15 min games plus 3 min between games.
- All playoff games will be played to 21 points (must win by two) with a hard cap at 25 points.
- The playoff round will be SINGLE KNOCKOUT.
- At the start of each game, captains will spin the ball – winner selects first serve or court side.
- After each game, captains must report their game scores to the check-in desk.
- Teams will referee and score keep their own games. If there is a team disagreement on a play, a re-serve will be called.
- Team players must call any violations on themselves (e.g. lift, carry, etc.), and the onus is also on the team captain to ensure all violations committed by his/her team are called.
- Spiking and over-hand serving are permitted.
- Blocking or spiking the serve is NOT permitted.
- Only female players may block female hitters.
- MINOR net contact is allowed unless it interferes with the play. Major net contact is illegal.
- Crossing under the net is illegal and must be avoided at all costs, for the safety of all players.
- If a player serves 5 times in a row, an automatic rotation will take place.
- Only players listed on your team roster may play on your team. Players can only play for one team in the tournament, unless authorized by the tournament organizers.
- Please keep in mind that this is a recreational tournament, and the emphasis is on **FUN**. Good sportsmanship by all participants is essential & expected.
- The tournament organizers will have the final say in settling any issues or rule disputes.
